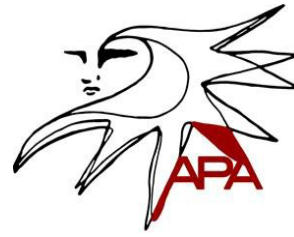


Technical Specifications

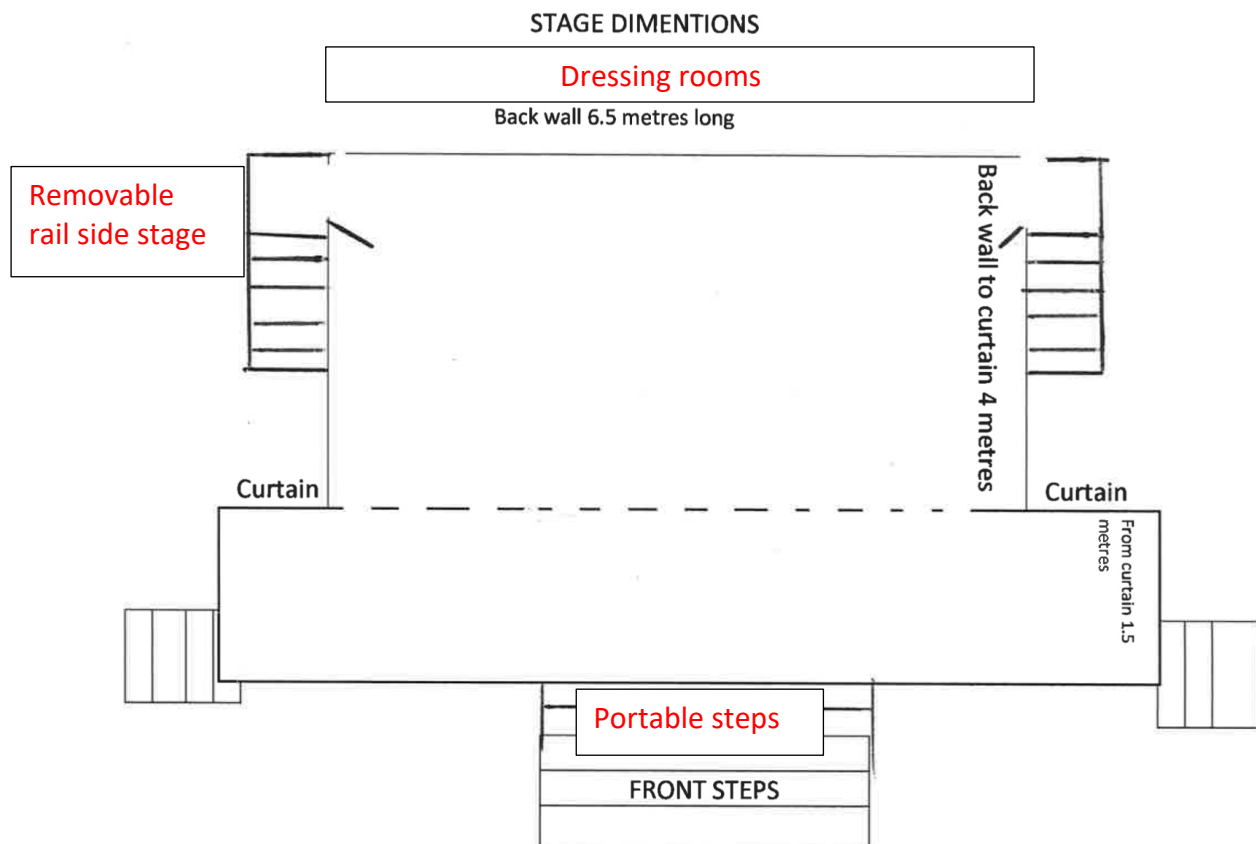

Load in & Load out

At the rear of facility, a large scout hall is available to store props and costumes through the side door of the hall, these can be dropped off from 10am Saturday (if you would like to drop them off on the Friday night, please notify the festival convenor). The stage manager can assist with access on arrival. Props can be dropped in between performances only, to prevent back stage noise between performances.

Access to stage

There are side steps up to the stage and a removable rail to load larger props, please be mindful of OH & S compliance to prevent any injuries for cast and crew. Maximum of 10 mins to strike set and 5 mins to bump out, please comply with these time limits to ensure efficient running of festival.



Tech requirements

Tech testing can be done before each session and NOT during a session, please ensure you check with the tech coordinator prior to your session commencing to go over any requirements and make yourself familiar with the operation if needed.

Lighting

The stage is lit with a down stage, up stage wash, left and right wash with no specials, lighting options are limited due to a recent refurbishment of the hall. There is a lighting operator for basic lighting assistance, the lighting operator will not be able to take on multiple lighting cues, if you need more than simple lighting operation, please provide your own lighting tech.

Sound Operation

There will be a 3.5mm jack (head phone port) available to plug into desk, and you will be able to run your sound off your own computer and/or device.

Please provide your own sound operator if you have sounds cues, there will be a technical person to assist with set up.

Dressing Rooms

The dressing rooms are located between the scout hall and the main stage, two companies ONLY can occupy this space at one time. As one cast loads out another can move in. Please use common courtesy in this space, reduce noise, remove all your rubbish and leave it tidy for the next cast. There are some outside toilets off the dressing rooms, please be mindful to prevent doors from slamming back stage.

Communal props list

We welcome visiting companies to use the communal props and share them while at the festival to reduce bringing bulky props on trailers and in cars across the state. These are conveniently located in the scout hall.

There is a dedicated person to manage all things back stage, please report to them on arrival and if you have any questions. They will let you know your call times and keep you updated if there are any last minute changes. Please remember to social distance and where a mask when necessary.
